Under direct supervision from the DPS aircraft program coordinator II, this Aircraft Mechanic researches and maintains electronic logbooks for 40+ aircraft operated by DPS, enters aircraft information into sophisticated online aircraft maintenance software, maintains on-line databases for aircraft records, updates logbooks and aircraft This employee will also maintain all aircraft records in accordance with FAA regulations. Additionally, this employee may perform Annual Inspections, preventative maintenance, and perform major and minor repairs on aircraft and all their parts and accessories for the operation of all Department of Public Safety's 40+ aircraft in accordance with Federal Aviation Regulations. The Fleet includes single engine land and seaplanes, single and multi-engine turbine powered aircraft, and reciprocating and turbine helicopters. These aircraft must be maintained and readily available 24 hours daily to respond to and ensure a safe flight over oceans and in all weather conditions, during transportation, search & rescue, and crisis missions and it is this employee's responsibility to ensure proper functioning of DPS Aircraft.
