At Enterprise Fish Co., the health and safety of our customers and employees are top of mind amid concerns about the spread of the coronavirus disease (covid-19). We are here to serve you, and we want to share information with you about how we continue to operate safely and effectively.

STEPS WE'RE TAKING

- Our management team is monitoring information from the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention, as well as federal, state and local agencies to help ensure the actions we are taking are in line with the latest CDC recommendations and guidance. We are communicating regularly with our employees to keep them informed and to ensure their safety and that of our customers
- Employees will be washing their hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after handling cash, credit cards, before and after breaks.
- Employees are asked to avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- List of items that will be by request only in order to limit handling exposure: all garnishes (lemons, limes, olives, etc.), salt & pepper shakers will be changed to packets, taffy & bread.
- Although we pride ourselves on "Going Green" we will be stocking the restrooms with paper hand towels as a secondary source to complement our Dyson hand dryers.
- Menus, Tables, Counters, Equipment, Bathrooms & Door handles will be routinely cleaned and disinfected by Staff

STEPS YOU CAN TAKE

- If you are sick, stay home.
- Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cough into your elbow or a tissue and not your hands. Dispose of the tissue.
