At DiSanto-Rose Dental we are committed to protecting the health and safety of our patients and team members. We have always and will continue to practice universal precautions and follow CDC guidelines on infection control in our office. Our operatories are thoroughly cleaned and disinfected after every patient. All our instruments are sterilized according to CDC and manufacturers recommendations.

In addition to this we are taking the following measures to keep our community healthy:

- Having team members stay home who are unwell
- Screening patients prior to appointments for any acute illness or exposure to people with acute illness
- Screening patients prior to appointments for recent international travel or contact with people who recently have travelled internationally
- Asking all patients to wash hands or use hand sanitizer when entering our office
- Minimizing wait times in the waiting room
- Frequent cleaning and disinfecting of doorknobs, waiting room and reception area

If any patients have had recent travel, been in contact with someone who has had recent travel or are experiencing any flu like or coronavirus symptoms we will be postponing dental work for a minimum of 14 days.
