Summer Time Around the Village

As we head into the summer we just want to take a moment and remember what a great place that we get to call home and that we need to make sure to take advantage of all that this area has to offer during the summer.



For starters, there is the Fred Meijer Nature Preserve which is known by most as Pickerel Lake. It is a perfect place for your early morning exercise, a mid day break, or a getaway after a long day of work. It has a really nice nature trail that circles the lake for over a two mile loop. In the evening, the sunsets can be viewed from the 900 ft. of boardwalk which is a fun spot to fish from, too.

Another way to experience our area is the Cannon Township trail that starts right in the Village and winds north along Joyce road and continues northwest to the Township Center. This section is about 4 miles long and is great for taking your pet for a walk or a nice stroll on your bike. Another section of the trail runs along Belding road which provides scenic views of Bostwick Lake. It is a beautiful and scenic trail that can provide great exercise.



Townsend Park provides many options from relaxing in a nature setting along the Bear Creek as well as access to the Township trail and miles of gravel roads that are great for biking. The park is a popular places for a variety of gatherings, as well. You'll find everything from impromptu family picnics to large wedding reception happening throughout the summer.



Soft shell crab lightly breaded and pan fried. Drizzled with a lemon butter and served with rice pilaf and seasonal vegetable.

Tri-Tip Steak with Chimichurri

Marinated grilled Tri-Tip with chimichurri sauce, sweet mashed potatoes and seasonal vegetable.

Smoked Prime Rib Steak
