Mr. Gordon White is the deputy chief of the Global Sensor Management (GSM) Division of the US Space Command Operations Directorate. The Global Sensor Management Division drives the vision, integration, and day-to-day operations of the Global Sensor Surveillance Network and is the USSPACECOM lead for determining and implementing GSM roles and responsibilities. Also serves as the lead organization within the J3 for Nuclear Command, Control and Communications and Missile Defense issues. Serves as the Secretariat to both the Integrated Tactical Warning Attack Assessment (ITW/AA) Mission Oversight Board and the Operations Approval Board. The GSM Division is responsible to the J3 Director to manage, synchronize, and integrate all aspects of Theater Missile Warning operations, engineering, policy, and change management functions. The GSM Division also serves as the COCOM HQ function, with SMDC as the lead component, for the Force Tracking (FT) mission.

Mr. White is a twenty-year veteran of the US Air Force where he served as a space and missile officer. His career includes assignments as a missile officer, space acquisitions, satellite operations, missile defense operations and acquisitions.
