## JOB DESCRIPTION:

Under direct supervision from the DPS aircraft section Foreman II, researches and maintains electronic log books for 44 aircraft operated by DPS, enters aircraft information in the CAMP and MTRAX system, maintains on-line databases for aircraft records, updates log books and aircraft paperwork to reflect airworthiness directives, service bulletins, Advisory Circulars and other paperwork. Maintains all aircraft records in accordance with FAA regulations, Additionally, may perform Annual Inspections, preventative maintenance, and perform major and minor repairs on aircraft and all their parts and accessories for the operation of all Department of Public Safety's 44 aircraft in accordance with Federal Aviation Regulations. The Fleet includes single engine land and seaplanes, single and multi-engine turbine powered aircraft, and reciprocating and turbine helicopters. These aircraft must be maintained and readily available 24 hours daily to respond to and ensure a safe flight over oceans and in all weather conditions, during transportation, search & rescue, and crisis missions. Aircraft are used by the Governors' Office; State Troopers, Wildlife Troopers and State Employees to conduct prisoner transports. The maintenance of these aircraft is vital to these critical missions.

Bore scopes, compression testers, Exhaust Gas Temperature tester, Cylinder Head Temperature tester, Multi-meter electrical test equipment, Fuel Quantity Indicator tester, Inner Turbine Temperature tester, Dead Weight tester, Fuel System Pressure tester, Vacuum Pressure tester, Micrometer, Calipers, Dial Indicator, various hand tools, sheet metal tools, Welding processes, Tungsten Inert Gas (TIG) and Oxy/Acetylene, various hoists, jacks, aircraft scales, torque wrenches, aircraft specialty tools, Heavy equipment such as front end loader, fork lift, trucks, vans, trailers, ATVs, lifts, stands, pneumatic tools, Non Destructive Testing equipment, microfiche, copiers are used on a regular basis.
