HENRIOT “HEMERA”, Incredibly Rare!!!
2005, Champagne, France 55 / 280
“Henriot Hemera, taking its name from the Greek goddess of daylight, has been launched as the house’s new top Champagne. It is made from 50% Chardonnay and 50% Pinot Noir and the wine is a blend of six grand cru Champagnes. This has a gold tinged color and an exquisite mousse, with full Chardonnay aromas of apricots, citrus fruits, toast and honey. It has a masterly grand cru Pinot mouthfeel of satin, subtle and honeyed, intense without heaviness.”
