PARISH NURSE NOTES: September is Celiac Disease Awareness Month – Celiac disease (CD) is a genetic disorder. In people with CD, eating certain types of protein, called

gluten, sets off an autoimmune response that causes damage to the small intestine. This, in turn, causes the small intestine to lose its ability to absorb the nutrients found in food, leading to malnutrition and a variety of other complications. It is a genetic, inheritable disease. Approximately in 133 people who have CD, only 3% of these people are diagnosed which means 2.1 million people have the disease and do not know it. Besides the malnutrition caused by the intestine not being able to process the proteins in grains, skin blisters known as dermatitis herpetiform can occur. CD is NOT a food allergy and does not result in allergic reactions like itching and trouble breathing. It is not age dependent, it may become active at any age. It is genetically linked and can be present at birth but not show up until years later. It is more prevalent in women than men. A gluten-free diet is one of the ways to control the disease. There is an organization to help educate and support those children with Celiac sprue (CSA), CSA's Cel-Kids Network provides children and youth opportunities to meet and share experiences with others of their age-group who are also living with CD/DH. www.csaceliacs.org For any help with any health related questions, please contact Marybeth Terrell at 301-845-6572.

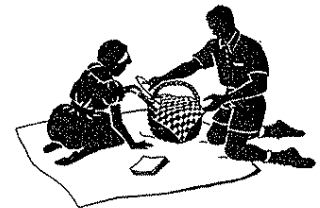
