

September 5, 2012
Parish Council Meeting Minutes

Call to Order

- The President called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

Opening Prayer

- Fr. Jason offered the opening prayer. Intentions were offered in prayer for Elijah Rubeling and Mrs. Poska.

Roll Call

- Members present were Fr. Jason, Deacon John, Deacon Jerry, Al Duke, Caitlin Buchheit, Ginny Abel, Steve Browning, Sandy Gordon, Bob Gorman, Robyn Jacobs, Bob Lilly, Kelly McGuire, and Mary Rash.
- Members excused were Pat Tramma and Meredith Rubeling.

Approval of Minutes

- There being no additions or corrections to the minutes of the meeting of June, 2012, the minutes were approved on a motion by Ginny Abel and seconded by Bob Gorman. The vote on the motion was 9-0 (President abstains from voting, in accordance with Constitution).

Announcement of Individual Communications to Members

- Communication from Chris Gordon, chair of the Finance Committee, to Bob Gorman: Audit is an official financial term that requires the auditor to follow certain procedures and be compensated for his time. Chris, as a CPA, wants to change the constitutional language so the council will not have to pay.
 - Finance committee – see the audit letter from archdiocese. Does the constitution need to be amended in order for this change of language to take place?
 - Diocese audits us every 3 yrs. Can we compare our language to that of other parishes?
 - Bob Gorman will work with Chris to resolve this issue. Bob will request a proposal from Chris with desired language. No objections to this suggestion.

Pastor's Comments

- Fall schedule beginning, with CCD, fundraising events, and Advent will soon be upon us.
- Email blasts to parishioners started over summer
 - 900+ emails at start, lost ~4 people who unsubscribed. Weekly messages – half have been opened, according to “read receipts”

- Carolyn – Psalms Class has 81 people registered
- RCIA – have 7 persons signed up; 6 youth, 1 adult.
- Year of Faith – starts in Oct. lasts thru Nov 2013. Committee formed – organizing events throughout year.
