40 DAYS FOR LIFE – SEPT 28TH THRU NOV 6TH: St Peter's will join many across the country and local churches here in Frederick, **starting this week**, in a powerful, life-saving campaign comprised of prayer as well as prayful vigil at the Toll House Ave Abortion Facility. **St Peter's days are the 5 Saturdays of October 8th, 15th, 22nd, 9th, and November 5th, from 7 am to 7 pm. THE NEW TRANSLATION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL



The Creed ("I believe...")

New: "*We believe*" will now be "*I believe*." The change from the plural, "we", to the singular, "I", now unites us with the entire Church. After Vatican II, English was the only language that translated the words to "We believe." "I believe" is an exact translation of the Latin, *Credo*. The use of "I believe" makes the faith statements that we profess in the Creed more personal. As individuals, we cannot speak for the collective beliefs of others present, we can only make a personal act of faith, i.e. *I believe in God the Father Almighty...*
