Every adult should have this discussion with their family so that their wishes are understood and can be honored. Completing an advanced directive does not have to mean that you do not wish for extraordinary measures to be used to prolong your life. On the contrary, if there is a situation and a decision to continue or stop treatment occurs, your health care agent who you have chosen can tell the doctor what you want IF they know! Do you know what the term "extraordinary measures" is? Do you want someone to know you want to be free from pain? Do you want someone to moisten your lips even if you can't drink? This is what can be spelled out in an advanced directive, completed by you . not a lawyer. We are not talking about who gets your property. We are talking about your wishes and dignity.
