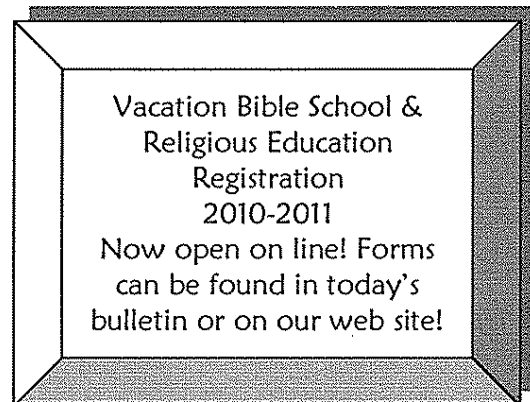
**YOUTH MINISTRY**

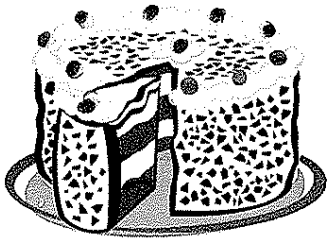

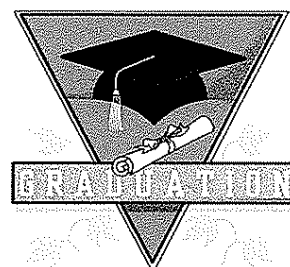
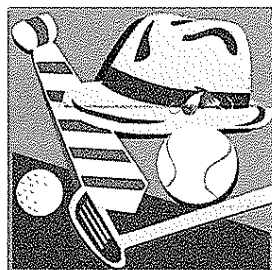

**PARISH NURSE NOTES: Stretching** – did you know stretching improves circulation! Stretching increases the blood flow for speedier recovery after you work those muscles in a walk or workout. It also increases flexibility and the range of motion of your joints. This will result in better balance which will result in you being less prone to falls. So when you start to stretch, warm up by walking for five minutes, then stretch each large muscle group . focus on your calves, thighs, hips, lower back, neck and shoulders. Don't bounce . use steady movement. Focus on the stretch until you feel tension but no pain. Don't forget to relax and breathe deeply . don't hold your breath. Now we've got it right!
