**100,000 ROSARIES:** The Archdiocese of Baltimore, in collaboration with the Knights of Columbus of Maryland, the Archdiocese of DC & Wilmington, is soliciting pledges to have 100,000 rosaries prayed in the month of March, 2012 to eliminate abortion in our state and our nation, and to pray for the families of those children who have been aborted. There are some 37,000 children aborted in Maryland each year – more than 700 per week. This is a rate that is 50% higher than the national average. While direct action to eliminate this killing is necessary, it must be accompanied by prayer. Can you pray 4 to 5 rosaries (only one per week) over the course of a month?
