FORTNIGHT FOR FREEDOM: The U.S. bishops have called for a "Fortnight for Freedom," a 14-day period of prayer, education and action in support of religious freedom, from **June 21-July 4**. Special events to highlight the importance of defending religious freedom have been planned throughout the Archdiocese; including the national kick-off Mass at the Baltimore Basilica, **June 21 at 7 p.m.** The fourteen days from June 21—the vigil of the Feasts of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More—to July 4, Independence Day, are dedicated to this "fortnight for freedom"—a great hymn of prayer for our country. Our liturgical calendar celebrates a series of great martyrs who remained faithful in the face of persecution by political power—St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More, St. John the Baptist, SS. Peter and Paul, and the First Martyrs of the Church of Rome. Culminating on Independence Day, this special period of prayer, study, catechesis, and public action would emphasize both our Christian and American heritage of liberty. PARISH NURSE NOTES: Vision Health

"Turn and answer me, O Lord my God! Restore the sparkle to my eyes..." Psalm 13:3 Your vision naturally changes as you age but medical conditions can cause additional vision losses at various times of your life. Your vision loss may be a difficulty with either the central or peripheral vision fields. It might be blurred vision, light sensitivity, night blindness, or even a hazy vision. Visit an eye care professional if you have difficulty with: close-up work or reading, determining colors, recognizing friends, reading signs, difficulty completing daily activities. It is important to determine if your problem can be treated with a pair of glasses or if it is disease related. An early diagnosis of glaucoma, cataracts, macular degeneration, or diabetic retinopathy will make a huge difference in managing your vision.
