YOUTH MINISTRY

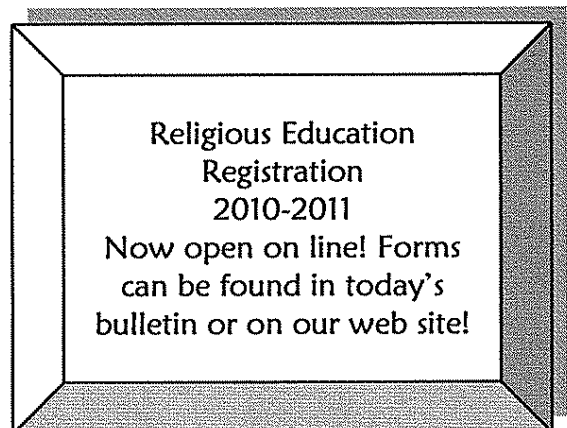

PARISH NURSE NOTES: Bike helmets help keep you safe. They only work if you wear the helmet correctly! Make sure the helmet fits snugly. You should not be able to move the helmet more than an inch in any direction. The straps need to fasten below the chin, not to the side. It is to be worn over the forehead but never so it interferes with visibility. Wearing a helmet is the most effective way to prevent a serious head injury. Remember we only have one brain and we have to protect it!!
