- 1). **CATECHETICAL FAITH FORMATION:** Weekly on Sundays, 10:15 a.m. - 11:15 a.m. (*Just think of all the graces you can accumulate in only one little hour!*) Pre-K and K; 1st and 2nd Grade; 4th and 5th Grade. This is a Lectionary-based program (meaning they focus on that Sunday's readings) and come with course outlines and suggested activities. from *Pflaum Publishing*.
- 2). **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION...FOR KIDS!** Weekly on Sundays, Time TBD 1 hour Children's RCIA (*Just think of the joy you'll have leading children home to Christ!*) This is also a Lectionary-based program and comes with course outlines and suggested activities from *Journey of the Faith*. - 3). **SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION:** Eight Evenings Total (four in October, four in March and First Eucharist Services in May) for 1 - 1 1/2 hours. This is a Sacramental Preparation Program from *Pflaum Publishing*.

**PARISH NURSE NOTES:** Head injuries in kids *"I will give you a wise and understanding mind such as no one else has ever had or ever will have!" 1 Kings 3:12*  
If your child plays a sport, be aware of the risk for a head injury. All athletes, parents, and coaches should understand the severity that can accompany a head or neck injury. Make sure all players wear the appropriate protective gear for the sport. If an injury occurs, carefully observe the player for signs of a concussion (severe headaches, extreme sleepiness, vomiting, seizures, leg/arm weakness, increasing confusion, or slurred speech). Don't allow the player to return to play until he/she has been evaluated and released. A second impact to an injured brain can cause serious and potentially permanent damage. Benched for a game is better than being benched for life.

**Our Lady of Guadalupe  
Silver Rose Icon Service  
Rosary, Readings and Litany  
Thursday, July 19<sup>th</sup>  
7:30 p.m.**

**HISTORY:** The Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program began in 1960 as a project of the Columbian Squires of North America to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. The program has continued since then as a project in several jurisdictions. Each year, a Silver Rose "honoring of Our Lady of Guadalupe and reaffirming our commitment to the sanctity of human life", is carried by Knights from Canada, through the United States, and into Mexico to arrive at the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico on December 12, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This year, four (4) Silver Roses are traveling to Mexico. The Silver Rose received in Maryland from New Jersey arrived on July 1st and will remain in Maryland for three weeks, until July 22nd when it will be delivered to Knights from West Virginia. The Silver Rose is in Maryland a total of 21 days, and a Marian Devotion Prayer Service is hosted each day as the Silver Rose travels throughout the State.
