THE NEW TRANSLATION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL



The Gloria ("Glory to God in the Highest...")

- **New:** The new translation addresses Jesus as the "Only Begotten Son." This language was used by the early Church to delineate how Jesus is the very Son of God who shares the same divine nature as the Father. John 1:12, 14, 18; John 3:16, 8 and 1 John 3:1, identify Jesus' unique relationship to the Father which we honor in the *Gloria*.

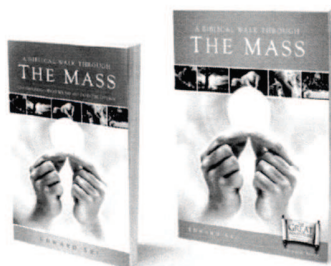

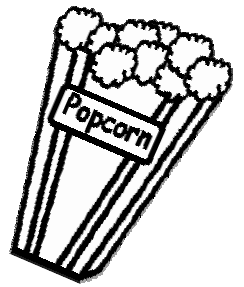
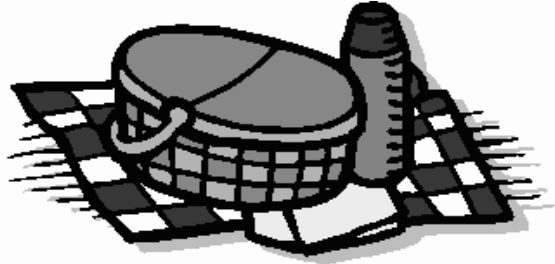
