**HISTORY:** The Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program began in 1960 as a project of the Columbian Squires of North America to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. The program has continued since then as a project in several jurisdictions. Each year, a Silver Rose "honoring of Our Lady of Guadalupe and reaffirming our commitment to the sanctity of human life", is carried by Knights from Canada, through the United States, and into Mexico to arrive at the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico on December 12, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This year, four (4) Silver Roses are traveling to Mexico. The Silver Rose received in Maryland from New Jersey arrived on July 1st and will remain in Maryland for three weeks, until July 22nd when it will be delivered to Knights from West Virginia. The Silver Rose is in Maryland a total of 21 days, and a Marian Devotion Prayer Service is hosted each day as the Silver Rose travels throughout the State.

**PARISH NURSE NOTES:** Brain injuries  
"Give me an understanding mind so that I ... know the difference between right and wrong." I Kings 3:9 Traumatic brain injuries can occur any time there has been a blow to the head. They can occur from a fall out of bed, a fist-fight, or accidents with bikes, rollerblades, or cars. When the brain is injured, symptoms can occur immediately, after a few days, or even after weeks have passed. Similarly, recovery may be quick from a mild injury or take months or years of rehabilitation to recover from serious injuries. Never minimize a head injury. Seek medical attention immediately for proper diagnosis and treatment. If the length of recovery is extensive, provide support and care for the family of the injured as it is their journey of recovery also.
