While on the island you get to learn about the role that Ft Sumter had in the American Civil War. Group **dinner** tonight at a favorite local BBQ. **(B,D)**

Day 6 Wed. April 3 Today we visit the amazing **Boone Hall Plantation** where you will see the Avenue of the Oaks, beautiful gardens, and original slave cabins that exhibit Black History in America. This afternoon we travel to Myrtle Beach. Enjoy an evening of fun at the **Pirates Voyage Dinner Show**. It’s swashbuckling excitement as pirates battle for lost treasure. We spend the next 2 nights in Myrtle Beach. **(B,D)**

Day 7 Thurs. April 4 A step-on guide will show us all that the “Grand Strand” has to offer including the **Brookgreen Gardens**, a botanical garden featuring sculptures.
