On July 20, 2018 Sister Cecille Elaine Green transitioned from earth to glory. Cecille was at home in Detroit, MI at the time of her passing at the age of 68 years old.

Cecille was born in Madill, Oklahoma on October 7, 1949 to the parents of John (JD) Davis Johnson and Daisy Johnson-Green. She was the 6th child of seven children.

Cecille was raised in the church and received Christ at a young age. After Cecille graduated from Ardmore High School in 1967. She married Lobius Green and they (Mia Johnson and her husband) moved North to Detroit, MI. She was a praiser, regardless of what she went through she praised Him. She searched the newspapers to find a sanctified church. Cecille was led to Zion Congregational (COGIC) under the late Elder Jesse T. Stacks which was her first church home. She then joined Prayer Tower (Conant) under the leadership of Elder Kenneth Collins. Her final church home was Perfecting Church under the leadership of Bishop Marvin L. Winans, where she joined in 1993. Cecille served in the choir (Perfected Praise) where she loved to sing God's praises with the saints. She also served with others at Perfecting Church in the Outreach Dept. Frequently she would visit Greater Apostolic Faith Temple under the leadership of Bishop Lambert W. Gates Sr. Cecille was baptized under the late Bishop Nemiah Smith (GAFT). Her membership continued at Perfecting Church until the day of her passing.

Cecille gained awards for her exemplary work in the banking industry. Cecille (Cil) dressed well, loved-loved perfume, loved to smile, laugh and took very good care of her husband, children, grandchildren and family (each one was special to her).
