HEFEWEIZEN/AMERICAN WHEAT

"Hefs" German style of wheat beer. Banana and cloves with an often dry and tart edge, some spiciness. Little hop bitterness.

WEIHENSTEPHANER HEFEWEISSBIER (DRAFT)

Brauerei Weihenstephan, Germany
The oldest existing brewery in the world, since 1040!
Rich yeast taste. The original ABV: 5.4% 7.5

BRAU-WEISSE (BOTTLE)

Ayinger Brewery, Germany
Full bodied, light tasting, wheat beer.
Distinct banana aroma with a champagne-like sparkle. ABV: 5.1% 7

ORANGE WHEAT (DRAFT)

Hangar 24, Redlands, CA
Locally grown oranges make this crisp, tangy, and refreshing. The citrus aroma, light airy mouthfeel, and tangy finish. ABV: 4.6% 7

FRUIT / VEGETABLE / KOMBUCHA

Flavored beer, with real fruit, veggies or probiotics.
Low bitterness to allow the fruit or vegetable to dominate.

MANGO CART (DRAFT)

Golden Road Brewing, Los Angeles, CA
A light Wheat Ale bursting with lots of fresh mango flavor and aroma, a lemongrass bitterness that balances and complements the fruity flavors. Finishing crisp and refreshing. ABV: 4% 6.5

PURPLE HAZE (CAN)

Abita Brewing Co., Louisiana
Wheat beer with raspberry puree added after filtration, so you may see raspberry pulp in the beer. ABV: 4.2% 7

PINEAPPLE CHILI HARD KOMBUCHA (16OZ CAN)

Flying Embers, Ojai, California
Juicy pineapple with a hint of ginger and a chili finish. Brewed with live probiotics and turmeric. Gluten Free, Vegan, 85 calories, 0 carbs. ABV: 6.5% 8

PALE / BLONDE / AMBER / RED

A good balance of malt and hops. Fruity and bitterness. American versions tend to be cleaner and sometimes hoppier, while British tend to be more malty and buttery.

RED TROLLEY ALE (DRAFT)

2012 World Beer Cup Gold Award. Medium-bodied beer with heavyweight malts for that toffee flavor. The perfect mix of hops for balance, and a hint of dried raisins and currants. The complexity of flavors makes Red Trolley Ale a hearty and truly enjoyable beer. ABV: 5.8% 7

SIERRA NEVADA PALE ALE (DRAFT)

Sierra Nevada Brewing Co. Chico, CA
Full-bodied, complex character with a fragrant bouquet and spicy flavor. ABV: 5.6% 7

805 BLONDE ALE (DRAFT)

Firestone Walker Brewing Co. Paso Robles
A beer crafted for the coast. 805 is a light, approachable brew. Born from an all malt recipe and finished with a touch of hops, it's slightly sweet with a clean finish. ABV: 4.7% 7.5

ARROGANT BASTARD ALE, AMERICAN STRONG ALE (22 OZ BOTTLE)

Stone Brewery Co, San Diego, CA
It is quite doubtful if you have the taste or sophistication to appreciate an ale of this quality and depth "Hence the Arrogance." ABV: 7.2% 13

ANCHOR STEAM BEER (DRAFT)

San Francisco, CA
The deep amber color, thick creamy head, and rich flavor. Since 1896. ABV: 4.9% 7

SAMUEL ADAMS BOSTON LAGER (DRAFT)

Two row barley, as well as German Noble aroma hops give it its exclusive taste. ABV: 4.75% 7

NEGRA MODELO (DRAFT)

Grupo Modelo S.A. de C.V. Vienna Lager
A very dark amber color, one of the finest Vienna/amber lagers that I have tasted. ABV: 5.4% 6.5

PILSNERS

German-style go-to lager. Light, well hopped with a herbal aroma and flavor.

SCRIMSHAW PILSNER (DRAFT)

North Coast Brewing Co. Fort Bragg, CA
From the finest European tradition, Munich malt and Hallertauer and Tettnang hops. A subtle hop character, crisp, clean palate, dry finish. ABV: 4.7% 7

BITBURGER PILS. (BOTTLE)

Bitburger Brauerei, Germany
The #1 selling Pilsner in Germany, a brilliant golden color, medium body. ABV: 4.8% 7

MAMA'S LITTLE YELLA PILS. (CAN)

Oscar Blues Brewery, Lyons, CO
Small - batch version of the beer that made Pilsen, Czech Republic famous. Made with 100% pale malt, German specialty malts and Bavarian hops. ABV: 5.3% 7

PILSNER URQUELL (BOTTLE)

Czech Republic
The Original, it is somewhat heavier (with an almost ale-like fruitiness in the malt body) and more strongly hopped. ABV: 4.4% 7

LITTLE BO PILS (DRAFT)

Smog City Brewing, Torrance, CA
Delicate spice, honey, and rustic white bread in the nose, meet the spice of traditional Czech Saaz hops and while the finish is crisp and bracingly bitter. ABV: 4.4% 7

BOOZY SELTZER WATER

WHITE CLAW PURE HARD SELTZER BLACK CHERRY OR MANGO (CAN)

The perfect blend of seltzer water, alcohol, and a splash of natural fruit juice concentrate. White Claw uses simple ingredients with no artificial flavors or sweeteners. Has no colors, no preservatives. 100 Calories, 2 grams of Carbohydrates/Sugars per serving. Made with all naturally glutenfree ingredients. ABV: 5% 6

TRULY WILD BERRY SELTZER (CAN) (GF)

Boston Beer Company, Boston, MA
With only 100 calories and just 2g of carbs it's sweet flavors of juicy California strawberries, raspberries & Marion blackberries with a refreshing finish. ABV: 5% 6

SOURS / WILD / GOSE

German-style go-to lager. Light, well hopped with a herbal aroma and flavor.

SOLERA (CAN)

Brewery Ommegang, NY
Rated Exceptional! Sweet, tart, sour. Malt and yeasty characters. Light citrus light vinegary sourness. ABV: 6.9% 7

SEA QUENCH ALE (CAN)

Dogfish Head Craft Brewery, Delaware
Lime peel, black lime and sea salt. It's a Union of three German styles of beer. Wheat and Munich Malt, a salty Gose ABV: 5.9% 7

FRUITLANDS - GUAVA PASSIONFRUIT (16OZ CAN)

Modern Times Beer, San Diego, CA
A sour starter for the beginner! A tart, fruity, & frighteningly delicious. Sour, salty beer lays a funky refreshment. Passion fruit and guava a tropical fruit fiesta. ABV: 5% 7

WILD LITTLE THING, SLIGHTLY SOUR ALE (CAN)

Sierra Nevada Brewing Co. Chino, CA
Just the right smack of tartness for serious refreshment, while guava, hibiscus and strawberry lend fruitysweet depth and a bright pop of color. ABV: 5.5% 7

BROWNS AND STOUTS

MILK STOUT (BOTTLE)

Left Hand Brewing Co., Longmont, CO
Milk sugar in your stout is like cream in your coffee. Dark, delicious, aroma and taste of roasted malt, coffee, chocolate, and a touch of vanilla. ABV: 6.7% 7

OLD CHUB SCOTTISH STYLE ALE (CAN)

Oskar Blues Brewery, CO
Gold Medal, 2010 World Beer Champ. Malted barley, beechwood-smoked malt. Cocoa, coffee, a kiss of smoke. A treat for malt heads who think they don't dig dark beer. One of my top five!! It tastes better in a fancy glass! Let me know what you think. ABV: 8% 7

BLACK BUTTE PORTER (DRAFT)

Deschutes Brewery, OR
Rated world-class by Beer Advocate! Crafted from chocolate and crystal malts, flagship brand since 1988. ABV: 5.2% 7

SCHNEIDER AVENTINUS WHEAT DOPPELBOCK (16.9 OZ BOTTLE)

Germany
This is a very intense wheat doppelbock with a complex spicy chocolate-like aroma with a hint of banana and raisins. Very rich and complex, with a hint of caramel. ABV: 8.2% 9

PEANUT BUTTER BEER STOUT (DRAFT, NITRO) *

Belching Beaver Brewery, Vista CA
Rated Outstanding! Peanut Butter Milk Stout is simply irresistible. It's like dark chocolate Reese's in a glass! Rolled oats and Lactose add to the creamy body of this beer while heavenly aromas of roasted buttery peanuts and chocolate greet you with every sip. Silver Medal – World Beer Championships 2014 ABV: 5.3% 7.5

YOUNG'S DOUBLE CHOCOLATE STOUT (CAN)

Wells & Young's Brewery, Bedford, UK
Pale ale, crystal & chocolate malt, a special blend of sugars. Dark chocolate and chocolate essence are combined to deliver a real stout. ABV: 5.2% 7.5

HOP HEADS

American IPA. (India Pale Ale). Big herbal and / or citric character, bitterness is high as well. Moderate to medium bodied with a balancing malt backbone.

GREEN FLASH WEST COAST IPA (DRAFT)

Green Flash Brewing Co. Vista CA
Hops include Simcoe for fruitiness, Columbus for hop pungency, Centennial for pine & Cascade for floral aroma. ABV: 7% 7.5

STONE IPA (INDIA PALE ALE) (DRAFT)

Stone Brewing, Escondido, CA
Well-respected and best-selling IPAs in the country, with citrusy, piney hop flavors and aromas, all perfectly balanced by a subtle malt character. Crisp, hoppy – rated 99 world-class. ABV: 6.9% 7

INCLINED IPA (DRAFT)

Santa Monica Brew Works, Santa Monica CA
Their top selling beer! Slight haze, dry finish, fruity hop presence. Peach, mango, pine and earth in a zesty bitter finish. Top it off with a great nose of citrus and tropical fruit trees! ABV: 7% 7.5

TWO HEARTED ALE (BOTTLE)

Bell's Brewery, Kalamazoo, MI
Rated World Class, Cult-like following amongst hopheads attests to its greatness. An IPA to reckon with thanks to its delicious hop-centric blend, balance and sheer drinkability. ABV: 7% 7

TRICERAHOPS DOUBLE IPA (DRAFT)

Ninkasi Brewing Company, OR
Rated Outstanding on Beer Advocate. Double IPAs are noted for their hop profiles. Earthy, floral hop aroma and flavor are abundant in Tricerahops. ABV: 8.8% 7.5

LAGUNITAS IPA (DRAFT)

Lagunitas Brewing Company, Petaluma, CA
Moderately hoppy, well balanced with cascade and centennial hops. Pleasantly spicy with just enough bitterness to balance the sweetness of the crystal malt. ABV: 6.2% 7

RACER 5 IPA (DRAFT)

Bear Republic Brewing Cloverdale, CA
This is a hoppy IPA. A full-bodied beer using American grains and two hops. ABV: 7% 7

ORDERVILLE HAZE AMERICAN IPA (DRAFT)

Modern Times Brewery, San Diego, CA
Fragrant beer that blends the fruitforward character. Immensely complex and enjoyable with massive, incredibly delicious hop character. ABV: 7.2% 7

BELGIANS

Witbier

A Belgian Style Ale, unfiltered and high level of wheat, that's used in the mash. Always spiced, generally with coriander, orange peel and other oddball spices or herbs in the background.

BLANCHE DE CHAMBLY (DRAFT)

Unibroue, Quebec, Canada
Belgian Witbier. Voted The World's Best White Beer with notes of dried orange peel and coriander seeds. ABV: 5% 7

ALLAGASH WHITE (DRAFT)

Allagash Brewing Company, Portland, ME
Allagash White is unique and truly refreshing. This beer is light and slightly cloudy in appearance, with a spicy aroma. ABV: 5% 7.75

DELIRIUM TREMENS (BOTTLE)

Brouwerij Huyghe Belgium
Belgium Strong Pale Ale. Has been voted the "Best Beer in the World." Belgium yeast, big but graceful sweetness, finishes dry. Clean, crisp, dangerously drinkable and delicious. ABV: 8.5% 10

RARE VOS AMBER ALE

Brewery Ommegang, New York (Draft)
Rated Outstanding! On the palate, the caramel maltiness shines strongly but with little sweetness. Dry fruity (yeast-affiliated), slightly fruity/hoppy with a beguiling spiciness. Moderate dry finish. ABV: 6.5% 8

DUVEL GOLDEN BELGIAN ALE (BOTTLE)

Brouwerij Duvel Moortgat NV, Belgium
Complexity and depth of an ale, refreshing nature of a Pilsner. A classic! One of my Favorites!!! ABV: 8.5% 9

Dubbel

A rich malty beer with some spicy characteristics. Lighter than Belgium Strong Ale. Mild hop bitterness with no lingering hop flavor.

MAUDITE DUBBEL (BOTTLE)

Unibroue Brewery, Quebec, Canada
Rated Outstanding! Beautifully crafted ale. Creamy and malty. Cloves and dark bread. A treat to appreciate this beer. ABV: 8% 8

CHIMAY RED (BOTTLE)

Bieres de Chimay (Abbaye Norte Dame de Scourmont)
A Trappist Ale with a sweet and strong taste that has a slightly apricot like aroma from the fermentation. ABV: 7% 9

Saison / Farmhouse Ale

TANK 7, FARM HOUSE ALE (BOTTLE)

Boulevard Brewing, Kansas City, MO
Rated Exceptional Beer Advocate. A traditional Belgian-style farmhouse ale, beginning with a big surge of fruity aromatics and grapefruit-hoppy notes, the flavor of this complex, straw-colored ale tapers off to a peppery, dry finish. ABV: 8.5% 7.75

Tripel

Brewers use up to three times the amount of malt than a standard Trappist.

CHIMAY TRIPLE WHITE (BOTTLE)

Bieres de Chimay (Abbaye Norte Dame de Scourmont)
Fruity notes of muscat and raisins give this beer a particularly attractive aroma which complements the touch of bitterness. ABV: 8% 10

TRIPLE ALE (DRAFT)

Allagash Brewing Company, Maine
Rated Outstanding! This strong golden ale is marked by passion fruit and herbal notes in the aroma, with suggestions of banana and honey in the complex palate. The Tripel has a remarkably long and smooth finish. ABV: 9% 8

GREEN'S QUEST TRIPLE BLONDE ALE - GLUTEN FREE (16.9 OZ BOTTLE)

Green's Gluten Free Beers - England
The best GF beer we have tasted. Light body for beer of this strength; spice and herb nose with flavours of candied fruit. ABV: 8.5% 11

Quadruple

Belgium Style Ale with a bigger kick of flavor and alcohol. Dark full bodied and a rich malty flavor, with low bitterness.

ST. BERNARDUS ABT 12 (BOTTLE)

Refuge de Notre Dame de St. Bernard
Ebony in color, smooth, creamy and full-bodied with extreme complexity and richness of texture that is very assertive, like a warming brandy. ABV: 10% 9

THE SIXED GLASS (BOTTLE)

Boulevard Brewing, Kansas City, MO
Rated 100 on Beer Advocate. Their Quadrupel Ale, also meant for the mature connoisseur, is a deep and mysterious libation, dark auburn and full-bodied, its sweetness deceptive. As good a Quad as I have ever had. ABV: 10.5% 8

Belgian Strong Dark Ale

Higher in alcohol, more of an all around character than the Dark Ale. Complex but a delicate palate. Spicy and alcoholic and great to drink.

CHIMAY GRANDE RESERVE (BLUE) (BOTTLE)

Bieres de Chimay (Abbaye Norte Dame de Scourmont)
Rich, brown Trappist Ale considered to be the worlds finest beer. We all agree it just makes you happy. ABV: 9% 10

GULDEN DRAAK ALE (BOTTLE)

Brouwerij Van Steenberghe N.V. Belgium
Dark creamy complex Triple. A treasure of a beer protected by the Dragon. Spot on, very smooth. ABV: 10.5% 9.5

Lambic – Fruit

LINDEMANS FRAMBOISE (12 OZ BOTTLE)

Brouwerij Lindemans, Belgium
Delicate palate of raspberries with undertones of fruity acidity, elegant, sparkling clean natural taste. ABV: 4% 9.5

CIDERS

ANGRY ORCHARD HARD APPLE CIDER (DRAFT)

Cincinnati, OH
Sweet apple notes up front with a subtle dryness at the finish for a balanced cider taste. (Gluten Free) ABV: 5% 7

ACE PEAR CIDER (BOTTLE)

Sebastopol, CA
Made with apple and pear juices and champagne yeast, cold filtered. Pear nose and a semi-sweet mouth feel with a dry finish. ABV: 5% 7

STRONGBOW, DRY HARD APPLE CIDER (BOTTLE)

Hertford, England
It is the world's leading cider. It is a dry cider with sharp apple aroma, fairly tart and quite refreshing. ABV: 5% 7

ACE PINEAPPLE CIDER (BOTTLE)

Sebastopol, CA
Believed to be the first original pineapple cider made anywhere in the world. They added pineapple juices to their fermented apple base to produce a 5% ABV cider that has a great pineapple nose and a semi-sweet initial taste with a tart finish. ABV: 5% 7
