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**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The incumbent will be hired as a WG56 Apprentice Equipment Operator as outlined in LOA 19-LL-021 which required this employee to meet certain skill levels/time frames as an equipment operator. Duties will be all-inclusive of general highway maintenance.

The schedule is 80 hours per week or 160 hours for two consecutive weeks, working an alternate workweek or alternate bi-weeks. Schedule is Thurs-Tue: 0600-1830 and Wed: 0600-1430. Wednesday is travel day. Travel to and from the assigned duty station from Fairbanks is provided by the State of Alaska, but the incumbent must provide their own travel to Fairbanks for further travel north. Due to an LOA, the employee will be on his/her own time.

\*Currently on a 2 week on / 2 week off schedule

Housing is provided but the employee will be billed a fee of \$105.00 per month. This fee helps fund miscellaneous expenses of camp living.

**THIS POSITION REQUIRES THE INCUMBENT TO OPERATE (i.e. chainsaws, hand tools, snow ploy, vehicles, sander, grader):**

This incumbent could operate many pieces of equipment. Including but not limited to, hand tools, chainsaws, snow plows, vehicles, sander, grader, etc.
