## RARE FINDS

**FAILLA “HAYNES VINEYARD” CHARDONNAY**

*2015, Coombsville, Napa Valley, California 30 / 146*

*“Ehren Jordan is one of those people who are maddeningly talented at many things. Jordan recently left his post at Turley, where he spent nearly 20 years making a dizzying array of superb Zinfandels. Did I mention Jordan is versed in the classics and is also a licensed pilot? Simply put, Failla is a reference point winery for the Sonoma Coast. This is as good as it gets.” Robert Parker’s Wine Advocate*

*“The 2015 Chardonnay Haynes Vineyard, from a site in Coombsville, is superb. Deep, pliant and flavorful, but not at all heavy, the 2015 is full of personality. All things considered, the Haynes is a remarkably fresh, nuanced Chardonnay in a year that tended towards heaviness. Ripe orchard fruit, chamomile and dried flowers meld into the inviting, textured finish. Judging by the wine’s freshness, Ehren Jordan picked this fruit on the early side. That seems to have been a spot on decision.”*

**CLOS MOGADOR**

*2014, Priorat, Spain 35 / 155*

*“The 2014 Clos Mogador is 49% Garnacha, 25% Cariñena, 16% Syrah and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon from the vineyard that names the wine (and the winery), planted on llicorella slate soils at 350 meters in altitude. There is great harmony on the palate, with very fine tannins and a velvety texture with great seriousness.”*

**HARRIS ESTATE “JAKE’S CREEK VINEYARD” CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

*2005, Napa Valley, California 35 / 160*

*“...is a young, virile and masculine style of Cabernet Sauvignon, with loads of minerality, blackberry fruit, damp earth and coffee as well as a full-bodied mouthfeel. Still youthful and promising, the wine is just beginning to enter its plateau of maturity, where it should stay for a good 15-20 years. It has texture, fullness and richness as well as purity...”*
