JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game / Sport Fish Division is recruiting for a Maintenance Specialist BFC Journey I position. This position is a full time, permanent position and is located at the William Jack Hernandez Sport Fish Hatchery in Anchorage.

The Journey WG 53 level performs work involving the full range of assignments normally associated with skilled work whereby the skill was gained through formal training or equivalent work experience.

A Journey worker is fully proficient. Work is performed independently, using standard methods and techniques, and consists of assignments that are typical of the occupational field. Journey workers can use a variety of interrelated skills to independently complete work that conforms to industry standards. **The work may require proof of competence, training, or certification.**

Areas of specialty identified for this position are Building / Facility / Systems Maintenance, Electrical, and Plumbing. Requirements are: knowledge of advanced shop mathematics, ability to perform multiple tasks in a variety of skilled trades, perform construction and maintenance repairs, use and operate tools, equipment, or machines of varying difficulty, perform physically demanding work, detect and identify needed repairs, read and write, and follow and apply written and verbal directions, make decisions and follow through to completion or resolution of a problem, respond to emergency situations following established procedures, and demonstrate sensitivity and interest in customer concerns and needs.

This position is one of four permanent maintenance positions at the William Hernandez and Fort

Richardson Hatcheries, and is expected to work as part of the hatchery team. The primary function of this position is to work with the other maintenance positions under the direction of the Lead Maintenance worker to schedule and perform preventative maintenance of hatchery facilities and equipment. This position also performs necessary repairs to hatchery facilities and equipment, and will be involved in some fabrication and modifications of equipment and systems to improve safety and efficiency of hatchery operations.

Hatchery equipment to be maintained includes 480 volt and 3 phase electrical systems, diesel powered generator, oxygen generating equipment, ultra violet disinfection systems, ozone generators, natural gas fired boilers, HVAC systems, air compressors, the hatchery well water distribution system and the wells themselves, a variety of pumps and motors used to move both fish and water, hatchery alarm system, vacuum pumps, and building and grounds maintenance. Good skills for troubleshooting, installing, and repairing electrical, electronic, and communication systems are desired for this position.

This position is also expected to assist in maintaining the hatchery structures in sound, safe conditions, adhering to OSHA standards. Operation of a skid steer loader, and all shop tools, including acetylene, stick, and MIG welding, is required, as is a valid Alaska drivers license.

All routine preventative maintenance and corrective maintenance is documented in the hatchery Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS), and this position requires computer literacy and the ability to learn to navigate and use the CMMS.

This position may rarely be called on to respond to emergency repairs after hours.
