

Understanding Your Medical Bill Starts with Your EOB

When you get a bill from a provider, and you are not sure if the amount you owe is correct, the most efficient way to confirm this is to refer to the I-Site portal on our website: www.stllaborers.com.

- **1** Go to the Member tab and select **I-SITE LOGIN**.
- ② Once logged in, choose the Claims option on the left column.
- **3** Locate the **date of service** for the medical care you received.

If you'd like to view your **Explanation of Benefits (EOB)**:

- Click on the **Claim #** of the service you want to review.
- Compare the information in the EOB to your provider's statement to ensure you're being billed correctly.

If you don't see the claim, contact your provider, as they may not have your current insurance information or may be missing important details about your insurance coverage.
