B. Week Long Series Method

- Each church will have a local evangelist preaching from the first Saturday till Thursday. Then everyone will come together the last two nights (Friday and Saturday) at one central location to culminate the series.

C. Location for last two nights of the series

- We will explore the possibility of holding the series either at the Gwinnet Center or the Atlanta Trade Center. Capacity for 3000 people.

D. Compassion 100K & Trainings

- The theme for the year will be Compassion 100K (See other attached document for more information)
- We will launch the Evangelism Plan with a Rally on **January 30th**.

- The Bible Workers are responsible to provide their own transportation and food.
- We ask the bible worker's to fill out a weekly report of their progress.
