Day 1 Saturday May 30, 2026

Overnight flight to Venice, Italy

Day 2 Sunday May 31, 2026

Meet our Italian tour director for orientation walk around the city known as the "Queen of the Adriatic".

Day 3 Monday June 1, 2026

Take a scenic cruise around the Venetian Lagoon to Murano Island where we will have a tour of the glass factory and see a demonstration of glass blowing. Cruise back to Piazza San Marco for a walking tour with visits to the Doge's Palace and St. Mark's Basilica. The evening is free to explore and dine independently. **B**

Day 4 Tuesday June 2, 2026


Today we travel to historic Bologna with its medieval architecture, the iconic Two Towers, and the oldest university in the Western World. After some free time for lunch on our own we continue to our hotel in Florence's city center. There will be an orientation walk with our Italian tour director. **B,D**

Day 5 Wednesday June 3, 2026

Take a walking tour of Florence seeing the Duomo, Palazzo Vecchio, and the Piazza della Signoria. We will visit the Accademia Gallery to see the famous David sculpture by Michelangelo. After lunch the rest of the day is free to explore on your own. **B,L**

Day 6 Thursday June 4, 2026

We're off to the Eternal City - Rome. Along the way we will stop in Orvieto for a wine tasting. In Rome we start with the Colosseum, the sight of many gladiator battles. This ancient structure was built between 72 and 80 AD and could hold 80,000 spectators. Use your free evening to try out the local cuisine. **B**

Day 7 Friday June 5, 2026

This morning we're free to discover Rome independently. In the afternoon we visit the Vatican for a guided tour of the museums, the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. Then we're off to dinner at a local restaurant. **B,D**

Day 8 Saturday June 6, 2026

We leave Rome and head to the World Heritage site of Pompeii, the city frozen by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 AD. We will have a guided tour of this archaeological wonder. As we continue down the road we will lunch at an authentic Neapolitan pizzeria before we reach our hotel in Sorrento. Sorrento is known for its stunning view of villas along the rocky cliffs and coastline. **B,L,D**

Day 9 Sunday June 7, 2026

In the morning we take the fast ferry across the Bay of Naples to the Isle of Capri where you have the day to independently explore. Check out the Roman ruins or the Blue Grotto and the beaches. After our return to Sorrento you have the evening free to dine and explore as you wish. **B**

Day 10 Monday June 8, 2026

Today it's a scenic drive to the chic village of Positano along the Amalfi Coast. You will have the opportunity to stroll through the narrow streets and browse the fashion boutiques as you head down to the beach. Here we start our cruise to Amalfi, a beautiful resort town known for handmade ceramics, colorful tiles and the ancient craft of papermaking. You'll have free time for sightseeing and lunch before we return to Sorrento for a farewell dinner. **B,D**

Day 11 Tuesday June 9, 2026

After breakfast we take our leave of Italy and fly home. **B**
