He was nicknamed the 'Fastest Man on Earth'. We'll then depart for **Penn Yan, New York** where we'll get checked in our hotel. (Night #1 of 3). Our hotel is located on the northern end of **Keuka Lake**. Dinner tonight will be onsite at the hotel.

Day 4, Wednesday, Aug. 5 (B, L)

This morning we'll travel to the **Corning Museum of Glass**. While there you'll enjoy a hot glass demo, in addition to the self-guided tour of the museum. We then travel to **Chautauqua Lake Falls**, for what will be a great opportunity for a group photo.... Then we're off to **Belhurst Castle** for a nice luncheon. Belhurst Castle, which is located on the northern tier of **Senaca Lake**, the largest of the Finger Lakes. The castle is rated #1 for the most romantic destination in the Finger Lakes region..... Later that afternoon we take a **scenic cruise of Senaca Lake** We then return to the Inn for dinner on your own and an evening free to enjoy the beauty around us. (Night #2 of 3)
