



FLIGHT RULES

ALL PASSENGERS MUST READ, UNDERSTAND, AND SIGN/DATE THIS FORM PRIOR TO FLIGHT.

The following information is to ensure that you have a safe and enjoyable flight

Federal Law:

- Absolutely NO mace, or any type of chemical agents are allowed on any aircraft.
- You must obey all Laws, Federal Regulations, and Directives from the Pilot.
- F.A.R. Part 91.11 states that:

“No one may assault, threaten, intimidate, or interfere with a crewmember in the performance of the crewmember’s duties aboard an aircraft being operated.”

INTERFERENCE on board aircraft will **NOT BE TOLERATED.**

This includes but is not limited to;

- Verbal or Physical Abuse
- Sexual Offences
- Refusal to follow instructions of the Crew or Pilot
- Endangering the Safety of the Aircraft or other passengers

If anyone violates these rules, the local Authorities will be notified *immediately!*

For your Safety, Please DO NOT

- Smoke near or in the aircraft
- Put arms up in air near aircraft
- Never walk under the rear tail cone
- Throw any objects out of or near the aircraft
- Approach or depart the aircraft near the rear
- Chase after any object that may blow away due to the aircraft
- Open door or remove seatbelt until directed to do so by ground crew or pilot

Ground Crew Procedure:

For your safety, you will be escorted to and from the helicopter. Please stay with your Ground Crew guide at all times. He/she will walk you to the aircraft and open your door for you. You may then enter the helicopter (***Please Do Not step onto the Skids or Struts***). After you are in the helicopter, our ground crew will put on your seatbelt and provide you with a headset for communication. Then they will close your door. If you need fresh air during your flight, there is a vent located on your door. Please Do Not put your hand, or anything else out of the vent. Before take-off and during landing, your pilot will need to communicate with the tower. Your pilot will not be able to converse with you at these times. When you arrive back from your flight, please stay seated in the aircraft until our Ground Crew come to escort you from the helicopter. They will open your door and remove your headset. Then you may take your seatbelt off and exit the helicopter. Your Ground Crew guide will then walk you back to a safe location.



DANGER AREA

In the event of an Emergency, please follow all commands by your Pilot. If for any reason you must exit the aircraft after an emergency landing, wait until the blades stop spinning if possible. If you have to exit while the blades are still turning, stay low! Always exit towards the front of the helicopter. In the event you need to use your life jacket, do not inflate until you are out of the aircraft or instructed by your pilot. If needed, there is a Fire Extinguisher and first aid kit located in the helicopter.

Air Sick bags are provided onboard, immediately advise your pilot if you become ill.
