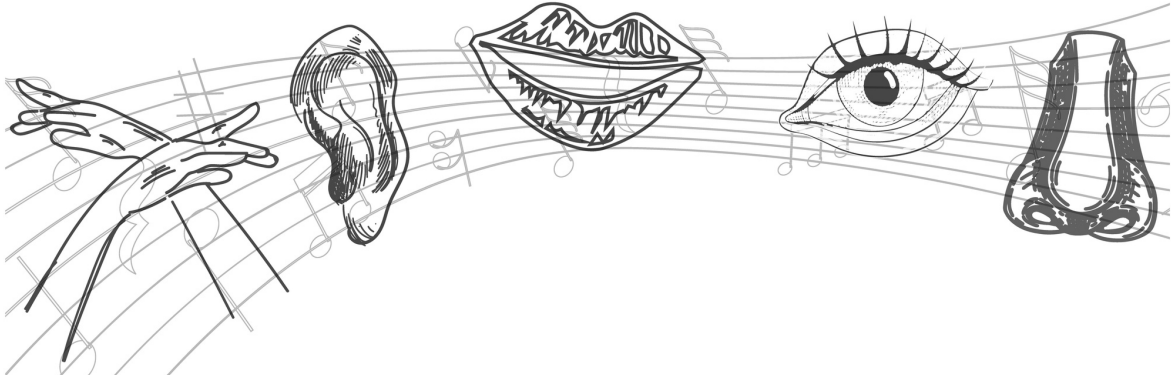
What's New-At a Glance

-Sick Policy: Dancers should be symptom free for at least 48 hours prior to returning to dance.

Recital Information

The theme for our 46th recital is Sense-ational Dance, a celebration of the five senses! The recital is held on Saturday, June 18, 2022 at the Macomb Center for the Performing Arts.

The recital and dress rehearsal are held at the Macomb Center for the Performing Arts. When arriving at the college for dress rehearsal and recital, enter through the stage door (located on the side of the Macomb Center, by the loading dock).

Tickets went on sale, April 1, 2022, online at macombcenter.com and at the Macomb Center box office. Be sure to check the lineup prior to purchasing tickets so that you know which show your dancer will be performing in. Please note that Macomb Center charges a processing fee per order. Due to fire regulations, the college requires every person in the audience to have a ticket (including babies and children). Ticket prices: \$20.00 in advance \$23.00 at the door

BEGINNING POINTE WORKSHOP-JUNE 20

This four hour workshop is designed for dancers beginning pointe this summer. It will cover all of the basics of pointe shoes including selecting the right fit, sewing and tying shoes, pointe safety and how to care for pointe shoes. The class, taught by studio Assistant Director Hannah Carden, will also include a beginning pointe technique class that will prepare dancers for summer classes.

MASTERS WEEK DANCE INTENSIVE-AUGUST 8-12

Ann Parsley School of Dance invites you to Masters Week - a week full of master classes, sponsored by the Macomb Ballet Company. Guest teachers from around the country will share their knowledge and expertise with dancers. This workshop focuses on developing technique and artistry. Dancers will sharpen their skills on specific dance styles including: ballet, pointe, jazz, hip hop, contemporary, lyrical, and more.

BALLET BOOT CAMP-AUGUST 24-26

For ages 8 and up, this 3 day mini intensive is designed to bridge the gap between the academic year and summer classes and to help prepare dancers for auditions. The boot camp will focus on body conditioning, non-syllabus ballet technique, pointe work (for students on pointe), stage presentation, quality of movement and audition tips. Dancers will have the opportunity to audition for the Macomb Ballet Company upon completion of the workshop.

Open Auditions

The Macomb Ballet Company selects its dancers through annual open auditions. Dancers can enhance their training with MBC without having to leave their home studio. Dancers must be between the ages of 8-25. The auditions are in the form of a ballet class with barre and center work. Audition attire for girls is a solid black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers and hair in a bun. Boys are to wear solid black dance pants, a white T-shirt and ballet slippers. Female dancers who are on pointe should bring pointe shoes. There is a \$25 audition fee. For more information, email at cdirector@macombballet.org.
