Dear Representative:

On behalf of the more than 530,000 members of the Laborers' International Union of North America (LIUNA), I write to ask that you co-sponsor H.R. 4696, the Renewing Immigration Provisions Act, also known as the "Registry Act."

LIUNA was founded more than a century ago by proud immigrants, and we continue to work for fair treatment of immigrant workers in this nation. LIUNA will continue to fight for comprehensive immigration reform and will not stop until it gets done. While we work toward this goal, LIUNA also supports immediate, concrete immigration policies that protect all workers in the United States. This includes strong border and humane immigration policies that support workers and the United States economy.

LIUNA has always believed that comprehensive immigration reform must also include providing legal status and work authorization to immigrant workers and their families already living in the United States. H.R. 4696, the Registry Act, does just this. It would update the existing law to allow immigrants to remain lawfully in the United States and have a direct path to permanence. Workers who have been in the United States for at least seven years and have a clean record would be able to apply for a green card. This legal status provides work authorization, helping workers secure and retain jobs, while helping employers to keep their well-trained and experienced employees. The Registry Act is needed now more than ever to stabilize the economy.

LIUNA asks that you cosponsor H.R. 4696, the Registry Act, to support United States workers, employers and the economy.
