Laborers' Local 110 Scholarship Fund

The purpose of the Local 110 Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance primarily to the children of active union members. The fund will provide assistance for tuition, fees and books. Scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be provided each year to 30 students, \$500.00 for each Semester (spring and fall) to the student. The application form is attached, additional applications are available at the Laborers' Local 110 office.

Criteria for Selection

The applicant must:

- a. Be the child of a Local 110 active member.
- b. Be a full-time student at an accredited college/school and complete a minimum of 12 hours each semester.
- c. Be a high school graduate or have a GED
- d. Maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average while in attendance.

To Apply:

When applying for this scholarship, the applicant must submit a written statement explaining what the applicant wishes to accomplish by attending college and point out any extracurricular activities in which the applicant has participated. A grade point average of 2.5 is required. Students who demonstrate that they have been active in school, church or community activities, will be given first preference. This application should also include the following:

- a. High school transcript with a minimum GPA of 2.5, or last college GPA
- b. Three letters of recommendation from current or former teachers or counselors
- c. Evidence of affiliation with Laborers' Local 110 (copy of members union card)
- d. Proof of College Registration showing credit hours enrolled for semester

Guidelines for Scholarship use:

Monies from this fund may be used for the following purpose in order of priority or combination thereof:

- a. Tuition
- b. College or Trade School
- c. Books and college supplies

Selection:

Applicants will be reviewed by a selection committee who will determine which applicants will receive the scholarship fund. Besides the required qualities, the committee will be looking for applicants who have been involved in extracurricular activities. The student(s) selected will have their names announced at the monthly union meeting.
