Parties to this agreement will be bound by the Ohio Laborers' Apprenticeship Standards. Each Employer party to this Agreement shall abide by the decision of the Joint Apprenticeship Committee. Per our agreement, the ratio of 1 apprentice to every 3 journeypersons.

Apprentice Wage Rates:

0 Hours -----	1000 Hours =	80%	\$21.28 (up to 144 hrs classroom)
1000 Hours -----	2000 Hours =	85%	\$22.61 (145 to 288 hrs classroom)
2000 Hours -----	3000 Hours =	90%	\$23.94 (289 to 432 hrs classroom)
3000 Hours -----	4000 Hours =	95%	\$25.27 (432 hrs classroom)
4000 Hours +		= 100%	\$26.60
