Media Influence & Ego

Commercials, movies, and music often glorify image, fame, and power. This creates pressure to promote ourselves, chase validation, and measure worth by reputation. For those in recovery, this mindset is a return to bondage — the old way of living in fear and pride.

Spiritual Centering

Step 11 teaches conscious contact with a Higher Power through prayer and meditation. In a world that promotes noise and attention, we rebel by embracing silence, humility, and inner guidance.

Practical Spiritual Application

Media Fasting:

Take weekly breaks from media that promotes violence, greed, or lust.

• Quiet Time:

Spend at least ten minutes daily in prayer or meditation.

Gangsters Anonymous Service:

Help others quietly — teach, clean, or serve without credit.

• Uplifting Input:

Replace negative content with spiritual readings or recovery material.

Group Reflection:
