Guinness Draught

Irish Dry Stout Dublin, Ireland 4.2% ABV

Guinness is an Irish dry stout that originated in the brewery of Arthur Guinness (1725–1803) at St. James's Gate, Dublin. Guinness is one of the most successful beer brands worldwide. It is brewed in almost 60 countries and is available in over 120. A feature of the product is the burnt flavor that is derived from roasted unmalted barley, although this is a relatively modern development, not becoming part of the grist until the mid-20th century.

Mutiny “I Patch Ale”

Session IPA 4.5% ABV 40 IBU

The hop flavor’s big, but like life on the open sea, we’re taking it easy. This Session IPA is brewed with lemon peels and dry hopped with Cascade, Amarillo, Centennial and Simcoe for a hoppy aroma of citrus, fruit and pine. Just right for long hot days, salty nights, or a day on the docks with your crew.

Heavy Seas “Blackbeard’s Breakfast” **Limited Release**

Imperial Coffee Porter Baltimore, Maryland 10.0% ABV 40 IBU’s

Blackbeard's Breakfast is a robust porter with a new world twist. Aged in bourbon barrels and brewed with Chesapeake Bay Roasting Company's Dark Sumatra coffee, this porter is flavorful and complex. Featuring unique English malts, this brew will have strong notes of caramel and a slight nut character. Paired with bourbon notes and the sumptuous Sumatran Coffee, Blackbeard's breakfast will please coffee and beer connoisseurs alike.

Two Pitchers “Bayou Milk Stout”

Stout - Milk / Sweet San Francisco, CA 5.6% ABV

In an ode to the bayou, this smooth, creamy milk stout is blended with New Orleans style coffee - cold brew, chicory, and a touch of maple. Laissez les bons temps rouler!

National Bohemian “Natty Boh”

Pilsner Eden, North Carolina 4.52% ABV

You don’t know about Natty Boh, hon?

3 Star Brewing “Two to the Dome”

Double IPA Washington D.C. 8.9% ABV

Big bright and juicy hop notes are the highlight in this smooth drinking beer. Generously hopped with Vics Secret, Azacca & Columbus to provide a big citric nose that leads the way for this tasty, rum-barrel-finished, double IPA.

Firesstone Walker “Double Coconut Mind Haze”

Imperial IPA Eden, North Carolina 8% ABV

This beer is so new and so rare that there’s really no information available about it out there yet. Let us know what you think of this power packed, tropical brew!

True Respite “Scrum & Hooker”

English Brown Ale Derwood, Maryland 5.5% ABV

Malty and traditional English brown ale. GOLD MEDAL winner in Brown & Amber Ales at the 2018 MD Craft Beer Competition, followed up with a BRONZE MEDAL for 2018 BEST IN SHOW.

Allagash White

Witbier Portland, Maine 5.0% ABV 28 IBU’s

Brewed with a generous portion of wheat and spiced with coriander and Curaçao orange peel, this beer is fruity, refreshing and slightly cloudy in appearance. Rated a perfect 100 points and proclaimed to be “world class” by the Beer Advocate.

Blue Point Toasted Lager

Amber Lager Patchogue, New York 5.5% ABV 28 IBU

Their World Beer Cup gold medal winning flagship brew is brewed with a blend of six specialty malts for a flavor as rich and unique as the town it’s from. Toasted Lager’s balanced flavor of malt and hops makes for easy drinking and their proprietary lager yeast produces an exceptionally smooth finish.

Heavy Seas “Loose Cannon”

IPA Baltimore, Maryland 7.25% ABV 45 IBU

The carefully cultivated interplay of Simcoe, Palisade, and Centennial creates a most fragrant IPA. Bitterness is somewhat subdued by the floral quality that pervades the taste. A strong malt backbone balances out the triple-hopped beer.

Union Craft Brewing “Rye Baby”

Rye IPA Baltimore, Maryland 6.5% ABV 78 IBU

Brewed with floor malted English Marris Otter and a hefty charge of rye malts, this beer brings a spicy malt presence to the scene. We hopped Rye Baby with copious amounts of Chinook and Simcoe to give it an amazing hop character that will make you the baddest delinquent in Baltimore!
